

Recommendations for Implementing Integrated Screening (IS) in Your Practice

- We recommend ARUP Laboratories.
- ARUP forms can be obtained directly from PAML. For delivery of these forms to your office, contact Patti Gable (509-969-9173). A sample form is available on <http://extranet.yakimamemorial.org/prenatal.html>.
- Complete your PAML form with your contact information for results.
- Fill out patient demographic data on the top of the ARUP form. Then, mark which screening you are doing. Exact dates for when certain samples can be obtained are in the top middle of the form.
- Complete “Required Patient Information” and “Additional Patient Information” on ARUP form.
- Currently the only place to have NT done is Cascade Women’s Healthcare Associates in Yakima, 453-8231. If a patient is having IS, complete the first part of the form and send with the patient to her NT appointment along with your PAML lab request. After they do the NT and complete that section of the form, they will send the patient and her form to PAML. PAML will draw the blood and send on to ARUP.
- After the first sample is received by ARUP, you will be notified of the optimal dates for the second draw. There will not be any results from the 1st draw.
- For second blood draw, you do not need to fill in the “Required Patient Information” or the “Additional Patient Information”, just mark the MSSIS2 on the ARUP form. You are responsible for completing the form and managing blood draw. Send the patient to PAML. After the second draw, you will receive results in about 2 weeks.
- Refer positive screen results to the genetics program (509-575-8160).
